Ideal for transplanting young seedlings, newly-set cuttings, and turf sod. Provides extra water soluble phosphorous to help stimulate root development. Excellent whenever tissue tests indicate the need for extra phosphate.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

General Use: 3 – 10 lbs per acre. Use this product as a foliar application to supplement the normal soil applied fertilizer program. Can be applied by aircraft at rates equivalent to 1 lb. to 1 gal. of water per acre. For back-pack sprayers use at the rate of 4 teaspoonful per gallon. For transplanting dissolve 5 lbs per 100 gallons of water.

Balanced nutrition is essential to optimum plant growth and yield.

COMPATIBILITY: **CHEM-SOL EARLY SEASON PREMIUM** is compatible with most pesticides commonly used on row crops including **Glyphosate** applications. Do not use with highly alkaline spray materials. Add **CHEM-SOL EARLY SEASON PREMIUM** to the spray tank when it is at least half full. Agitation is suggested to increase the speed of solubility.
